Chairman's Report

My report to Members last year was written on the eve of our return to a renovated and remodelled Redfern Oval. One year on, our state of the art home at Redfern Oval has become the centrepiece of everything we now do at the Rabbitohs and serves as a fitting tribute to the strong relationship we enjoy with the Council of City of Sydney and with our other partners and stakeholders who have contributed to making this facility the envy of other clubs in our game.

In my own association with the Club over the last decade, I cannot recall such a surge of support for a forthcoming season. Of course, star recruits Sam Burgess and David Taylor have underpinned much of this renewed interest in our Club among our fans and the sporting public generally. But allied to this has been a growing awareness that our squad is at last attaining that special blend of youth and experience that brings good results on the field. Added to this has been the sage-like knowledge that John Lang now brings to the Head Coach's position which has served to galvanise our squad of players into a unified and determined group, eager to deliver results for our Members and fans.

In terms of financial performance, I am pleased to report that the 2009 year delivered the anticipated impressive results. Revenues rose by over \$1.1 million and operating expenditure decreased by \$1.6 million, all resulting in a very favourable operating profit of \$234,815. As will be evident from the notes to the financial statements, this compares very favourably with last year's result and accords with the Football Club's firm commitment to deliver improved financial results without further investor funding.

As we embark upon a season full of promise, it is important for me to acknowledge again the significant role all our sponsors have played in the slow rebirth of our Club. From NAB, DeLonghi, Virgin Blue and V8 Super Cars at the top, to our host of mid-tier sponsors and to our ever reliable army of small business sponsors, our Club is able to draw upon solid corporate and business support, all of which underpins its successes both on and off the field.

On the Member Co. Board, it has been a pleasure again to serve with Nik Hatzistergos, Jim Hatfield, Ray Martin and Ken Stewart, all of whom continue to contribute to the Club in a spirit of co-operation and generosity. I thank

each of them for the commitment they have shown in ensuring that Members' rights are protected at all times and that the core heritage values of the Rabbitohs remain undisturbed.

I sign off this Report with great expectation for the year ahead. As the Rabbitohs lead the race towards 10,000 ticketed members, it is only fitting that I close by thanking each and every one of you for the committed support you have given our Club through its gradual transformation into a leading club in the NRL.

4. PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

The principal activities of the Company during the course of the year were the administration and management of members' interests in the South Sydney District Rugby League Football Club Limited ("the Football Club").

There were no other significant changes in the nature of the activities of the Company during the period.

5. OPERATING AND FINANCIAL REVIEW

The operating result for the year was nil (2008: nil). This result was after deriving \$358,591 (2008: \$317,323) in membership subscription revenue, awarding grants to the South Sydney District Rugby League Football Club Limited ("the Football Club") of \$110,875 (2008: \$84,661) and recognising a share of the trading losses of the Football Club of nil (2008: nil).

The Company operating profit before financing costs of South Sydney District Rugby League Football Club Limited for the year was \$234,815 (2008: loss of \$2,554,919), and the Company operating loss after financing costs was \$258,527 (2008: \$2,828,925) before taking in to account exceptional items.

6. MEMBERSHIP

The Company is a company limited by guarantee and without share capital. The number of members as at 31 October 2009 was 11,270 (2008: 9,973).

7. ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION

The Company is subject to various environmental regulations under both Commonwealth and State Legislation.

The Board believes that the Company has

adequate systems in place for the management of its environmental requirements and is not aware of any breach of those environmental requirements as they apply to the company.

8. DIVIDENDS

The Company is a company limited by guarantee and is prevented by its constitution from paying dividends.

9. EVENTS SUBSEQUENT TO REPORTING DATE

There has not arisen in the interval between the end of the financial year and the date of this report any other item, transaction or event of a material and unusual nature likely, in the opinion of the directors of the Company, to affect significantly the operations of the Company, the results of those operations, or the state of affairs of the company, in future financial years.

10. LIKELY DEVELOPMENTS

The directors do not anticipate any particular change in the operations of the Company that will affect the results in subsequent years.

11. INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE OF OFFICERS

The Company has paid insurance premiums of \$6,903 (2008: \$6,801) in respect of directors' and officers' liability and legal expense insurance contracts, for current and former directors and officers, including senior executives of the Company and directors, senior executives and secretary of the company. The insurance premiums relate to:

- costs and expenses incurred by the relevant officers in defending proceedings, whether civil or criminal and whatever their outcome; and

- other liabilities that may arise from their position, with the exception of conduct involving a wilful breach of duty or improper use of information or position to gain a personal advantage.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS OF THE INCOME STATEMENT

The Company's total revenue for 2009 increased by \$41,268 to \$358,591. Total operating expenses have increased by \$15,054 with the Company also awarding grants of \$110,875 and recognising a share of the losses of the Football Club amounting to nil.

Individual items that have significantly impacted the result include:

- Increase in the payment of a grant to the Football Club by \$26,214 (31%) and;
- Increase in membership revenue by \$41,268 (13%), reflecting an increase of 1,297 Members.

- (a) Other than in respect of any of the matters set out in (b) below, the holder of the Preference Share has no voting rights at any meeting of Members except in respect of any resolution proposing to amend or otherwise adversely affect the rights attaching to the Preference Share.
- (b) At all times while the Company remains a public company limited by guarantee and owns the legal and beneficial interest in the Preference Share, SSDRLFC must not, without the consent of the Company as holder of the Preference Share:

(i) enter into a merger, joint venture, amalgamation or any similar form of arrangement with any other rugby league club;

(ii) make any decision to list the share capital of SSDRLFC or a derivative business of SSDRLFC on the official list of a stock exchange; or

(iii) change the Football Team's:

(A) team colours from Cardinal Red and Myrtle Green (other than where the design incorporates colours other than Cardinal Red and Myrtle Green due to maker's marks or any minor modifications which are in line with other teams and trends);

(B) name from "South Sydney District Rugby League Football Club" or "Rabbitohs";

(C) rabbit logos (other than any minor modifications which are in line with other teams and trends);

(D) home ground to a venue outside the South Sydney District (excluding ANZ Stadium formerly known as Telstra Stadium); or

(E) team song ("Glory, Glory to South Sydney").

(c) The Preference Share entitles the holder to appoint two representatives to serve as Directors.

(d) The Preference Share has no right to receive dividends.

(e) The Preference Share is not transferable.

(f) The Preference Share must not be purchased pursuant to a selective buy back without the written consent of the holder of the Preference Share.

(g) No more than one Preference Share may be issued.

(h) The Preference Share entitles the holder to priority in repayment of the amount of \$1.00 paid up on the Preference Share in priority to all other Shares in SSDRLFC in the event of winding up of SSDRLFC, and thereafter, has no further right to participate in any further assets of SSDRLFC upon its winding up.

THE BEGINNING.....

South Sydney District Rugby League Football Club was formed at a public meeting held at Redfern Town Hall on 17 January 1908.

On March 5, 1908, the NSW Rugby League issued the Club its receipt No. 2 for their £ -1 - 1 - 0 affiliation fee.

The Club's first premiership match, also the first in the NSWRL competition, was played at Birchgrove Oval on Easter Monday, 20 April 1908. Souths defeated North Sydney 11-7. Winger Tommy Anderson scored Souths first try, with others added during the historic game by forwards Dick Green and Harold Butler, who also kicked a goal.

The Club was incorporated as a company limited by guarantee at a Special General Meeting on 13 June 1982.

The rebirth of the Rabbitohs began on 7 June, 2006 through a new partnership between Russell Crowe, Peter Holmes à Court and the 8000 Members of the Club. The voting Members of the Football Club voted by a 75.8% majority to convert the Club from a company limited by guarantee to a company limited by shares at an Extraordinary General Meeting held on 19 March 2006.
